## Centers/Independent Work: Writing – Glue the Tools in the Toolbox

Level 1  
Worksheet 1.3

### Objective:

This activity supports individual learning outcomes as students complete tasks at their own levels, reinforcing symbol recognition and fine motor skills.

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### Materials:

- Glue the tools in the toolbox worksheet (provided)
  - Scissors
  - Glue
  - Crayons/markers
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### Instructions:

1. Print the glue the tools in the toolbox page (1 per student).
  2. Cut out the tool images on the bottom of the worksheet.
  3. Provide students with:
    - a. Worksheets
    - b. Pre-cut tool images
    - c. Glue
  4. Direct students to:
    - a. Color the tools and the toolbox.
    - b. Glue the pre-cut tools onto the toolbox worksheet.
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### TEACHING IDEAS FOR CENTERS

- If student has the fine motor skills, encourage them to try cutting out tool images.

### TEACHING IDEAS FOR INDEPENDENT WORK
