

Centers/Independent Work: Math – Comparing Dinosaur Numbers 1

Level 2 Worksheet 2.3

Objective:

This activity supports individual learning outcomes as students complete tasks at their own levels, reinforcing symbol recognition, matching, and counting.

Materials:

- · Comparing dinosaur numbers 1 worksheets (provided)
- Pencils or markers

Instructions:

- 1. Print the comparing dinosaur numbers 1 pages (1 set per student).
- 2. Provide students with pencils or markers.
- 3. Optional: laminate the worksheets for reuse and provide students with a dry erase marker to write directly onto the laminated sheets.

TEACHING IDEAS FOR CENTERS

- Encourage students to **circle** the numbers on the number line: the number to the right is more and the number to the left is less.
- Write the words "more" and "less" with an image to use as a visual reminder.

TEACHING IDEAS FOR INDEPENDENT WORK


- When working through this lesson, use a structured work system to encourage independence. Ideas for structured work systems can be found in Routine Essentials: Independent Work Systems.
