

How to Use the Links Curriculum Lesson Plans

- 1) Review the list of Links lessons on the Links Assessment
 - The Links curriculum assessment is available by clicking on the Lesson tab/Lesson Assessment tab
 - or
 - Print a copy of the assessment booklet by clicking on Support/Resources/Links Assessment
- 2) Identify appropriate lessons to teach the student
 - Conduct a student assessment using the Links Assessment
 - Or
 - Simply identify the lessons needed for each student based on teacher perception or other assessment data
- 3) Find the appropriate lesson plans
 - Links lesson plans are under the tab “Lessons/All lesson plans.” Print the lesson plans selected.
- 4) Print the Instructional Data Form for each lesson plan selected. Data sheets are located in Support/View resources/Lesson Resources/Instructional Data Form
- 5) Photo cards (if needed):
 - Links photo cards are in Lesson/Visuals for Lessons and can be printed
- 6) Read the lesson plan
- 7) If needed, watch the video associated with each lesson plan
 - Links videos are embedded in the Links system with the Lesson Plans (Lessons/All Lesson Plans, then click the 3 dots)
- 8) Practice the lesson prior to working with the student if possible
- 9) Implement the lessons with the student
