PRT Observation Guidelines:

- 1. When observing in the classroom, it is important to not cause any disruption to the session. Please do not ask the teacher questions, stand too close to the area, or provide feedback to the student.
- 2. If the student has difficulty focusing on the lessons and is looking at you, move away and ask the coach to find a different session to observe.

Observation Instructions:

- 1. Review the PRT Teaching Procedures Chart (attached).
- 2. Observe students throughout the session during routine activities (table time, circle, group, sensory, snack).
- 3. Complete the chart below noting when you have observed a short PRT trial used during the routine.
