Routine Prompting Observation

Routine Observation Guidelines:

1. When observing in the classroom, it is important to not cause any disruption to the session. Please do not ask the teacher questions, stand too close to the area, or provide feedback to the student.
2. If the student has difficulty focusing on the routine and is looking at you, move away and reduce distractions for the student.

Observation Instructions:

1. Select a routine to observe.
1. Review the prompt level chart (attached).
2. Watch a student performing the steps of the routine and notice the prompt levels given.
3. Complete the form below noting the prompt level given.
4. Discuss your observations with the group.
