

Routine Data Collection



Routine Observation Guidelines:

- 1. When observing in the classroom, it is important to not cause any disruption to the session. Please do not ask the teacher questions, stand too close to the area, or provide feedback to the student.
- 2. If the student has difficulty focusing on the routine and is looking at you, move away and reduce distractions for the student.
- 3. This assignment requires you to shadow a lead teacher or assistant teacher and take simultaneous routine data.

Observation Instructions:

- 1. Discuss with the teacher which students will have routine data collected.
- 2. Ask the teacher for a copy of the routine data form (make a copy, do not use the student's actual data form).
- 3. As the student performs the routine, simultaneously take data on the student's performance on the routine.
- 4. After the routine has been completed, as the teacher for a copy of the data they collected.
- 5. Observe 3-5 routines (it can be over the course of several days).
