


# **Model Site Development**

- Train teams to use research-based strategies across tiers of support

# **Paraprofessional Training**

#### **Research Shows:**

- Paraprofessionals actively desire more training on evidence-based practices (EBPs)
- Investment in paraprofessional training leads to increased skills
- Training improves job satisfaction and staff retention
- Contributes to schools' capacity building to better serve students' needs

- ★ Basic Behavior Principles
- Teaching New Behaviors
- Understanding Reinforcement
- Using Visual Supports
- Teaching Communication
- Curriculum implementation for paraprofessionals
