


Changing Activities Tools – Responding to an Unexpected Change Social Script


Instructions:

Dealing with Change




At school, I follow a schedule. My teacher plans the schedule. Some activities on my schedule may be morning meeting, small group activity, P.E., lunch, and math.

Dealing with Change


