

CREATING SOCIAL SCRIPTS

The “Simple” Strategy

Select Select a behavior you want to change or a behavior you want to teach.

Identify Identify what you want students “to do” when the problem behavior occurs.

Make Make a social script centered around the problem behavior and what you want the student to do instead.

Perspective Perspective is important: create the social script from the student’s point of view.

Look Look for the right opportunity to implement your social script—ideally, this should be prior to the challenging behavior.

Evaluate Evaluate your data to see if adjustments need to be made to the social script.
