Needed:

- Scissors
- Stapler or hole punch
- Ring for binding purposes (optional)

Preparation:

- I. Prepare the songbook:
 - a. Print a set of songbook pages (I set for the class or I set per student).
 - b. Cut, laminate, and assemble the pages in order.
 - c. Staple the pages together, or hole-punch the top left corner of the pages and secure them together with a ring.
- 2. Display the completed songbook so that all students can access and reference it.
- 3. Familiarize yourself with the melody of the song ("Teddy Bear, Teddy Bear, Turn Around").






