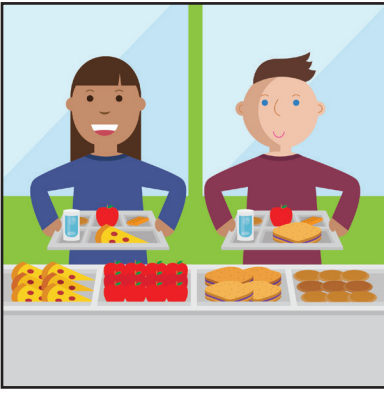
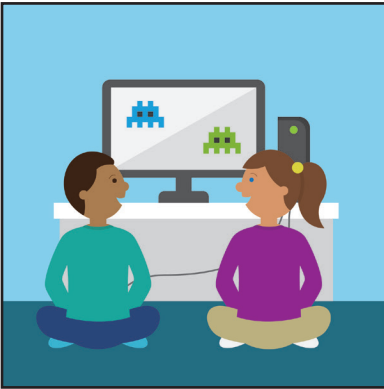


Instructions:

1. Print, laminate and cut the Social Scenarios.
2. Place the scenarios in a bag.
3. Pair up students or have students choose a partner.
4. Each pair selects a scenario from the bag.
5. Partners read the scenario (to themselves), select roles, and practice “acting out” the scenario.
6. Gather students in a group.
7. Select a pair to act out their scenario.
8. Other students guess the scenario.
9. Repeat until all pairs have participated.



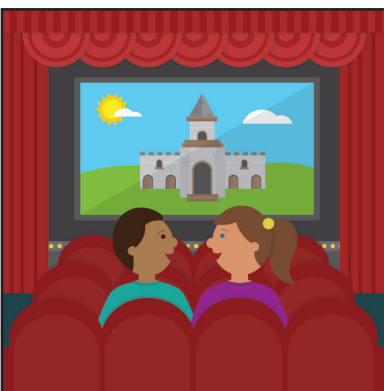
You are in the lunch line in the cafeteria. You notice that the person next to you is a new student.



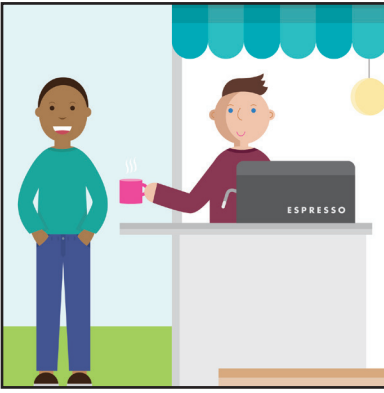
On Friday night, you go to your best friend's house to hang out. You both like to play video games.

You want to go to the movie theater to see a new movie. Invite a friend to go with you.



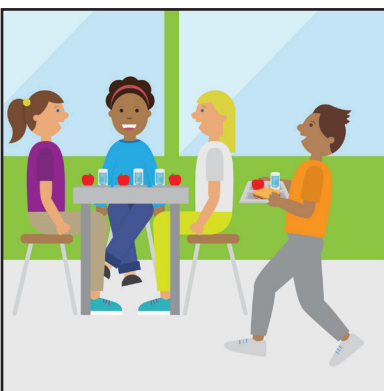
You order a coffee at the school coffee stand and the clerk asks you about your day.
