Centers/Independent Work: Reading – Weather Sentences 2

Objective:

- 3. Students should:
 - a. Read the sentences.
 - b. Draw or cut out and glue on the image(s) accurately depicting the content of the sentences.

- Use a finger puppet or toy to encourage students to track the words with their fingers.


TEACHING IDEAS FOR INDEPENDENT WORK
