# **Centers/Independent Work: Writing - Fairy Tale Words 1**

Level 3 Worksheet 3.1

## **Objective:**

This activity supports individual learning outcomes as students complete tasks at their own levels, reinforcing symbol recognition and fine motor skills.

#### **Materials:**

- Fairy tale words 1 worksheets (provided)
- Crayons or markers

#### Instructions:

- 1. Print the fairy tale words 1 pages (1 set per student).
- 2. Provide students with:
  - a. Worksheets
  - b. Crayons or markers
- 3. Direct students to trace the words.
- 4. Optional: laminate the worksheets for reuse and provide students with a dry erase marker to write directly onto the laminated sheets.

### **TEACHING IDEAS FOR CENTERS**

- Encourage students to draw the letters correctly, starting on the top line and tracing down or around.
- Provide visual cues by placing a dot on each letter to orient the student where to place his or her pencil to begin drawing the letter.

## **TEACHING IDEAS FOR INDEPENDENT WORK**

- When working through this lesson, use a structured work system to encourage independence. Ideas for structured work systems can be found in Routine Essentials: Independent Work Systems.
- **Please note:** All tasks presented during independent work should be tasks the student can complete without additional prompting.


