Sports and Hobbies Art – Name Banner



Objective:

Your child will use gross motor skills and shape and pattern recognition to practice independence and fine motor skills to create a piece of art.

Materials:

- Step-by-step guide (provided)
- Triangle template (provided)
- Circle template (provided)
- Construction paper (white and various colors)
- Hole punch

- Yarn
- Black markers
- Scissors
- Glue

Preparation:

- I. Print the step-by-step guide (I per child).
- 2. Print, laminate, and cut:
 - a. Triangle template
 - b. Circle template
- 3. Set aside an extra set of materials for you to use as you demonstrate the activity.
- 4. Create a name banner for reference; place these in a location visible to your child.
- 5. Provide your child with a triangle template, circle template, construction paper, hole punch, black crayon or marker, scissors, and yarn.

Teach Independence:

- Children should complete the art project as independently as possible. Provide physical assistance when needed, but encourage your child to work independently.
- Place art materials in separate containers.
- Encourage your child to gather their materials prior to the art activity.

Ideas to Encourage Social/Communication Skills

- Encourage your child to work with a sibling or a friend to create a shared art project.
- Throughout the activity, encourage descriptive conversation about each art piece (the colors, the words the colors represent, the amount of color, etc.).
- Encourage your child to show others their completed project.

Considerations:


- If completing this activity at home with your child, consider setting up a simulation/pretend activity. Some ideas include:
 - Include siblings, friends, or other family members if you would like.
 - For materials that need to be pre-cut or pre-made, organize them and place them in the area you will be doing art.
 - For other common household art materials, keep them in their usual place and teach your child where those items are located in the home.
 - Complete each step of the art project together as a visual model of the art activity.

Step-by-Step Guide


Ount how many letters are in your name.



2 Trace around the triangle template on colored paper, making sure to trace one triangle for each letter of your name. Cut out the triangles.



3 Trace around the circle template on white paper, making sure to trace one for each letter of your name. Cut out the circles.



Using the black marker, write one letter of your name on each circle.



5 Glue each letter circle to the middle of each triangle.



6 Punch two holes at the corners of the short side of each triangle.

7 Using the yarn, thread the triangles together, making sure they correctly spell your name.
