

Objective:

This activity pairs gross motor skills with shape and pattern recognition to practice independence and fine motor skills as students follow a sequence of tasks to create a piece of art.

Materials:

- Step-by-step guide (provided)
- Pipe cleaners (I per child)
- Straws (assorted colors; 2–4 per child)

- Bowl
- Basket
- Scissors

Preparation:

- I. Print the step-by-step guide (I per child).
- 2. Cut straws into equal sized "beads." Make enough "straw beads" to fill the length of a six-inch-long bracelet.
- 3. Place the beads into the bowl.
- 4. Cut the pipe cleaners to bracelet length (five to six inches).
- 5. Set aside an extra set of materials for you to use as you demonstrate the activity.
- 6. Create a friendship bracelet for reference; place the model in a location visible to your child.
- 7. Provide your child with a pipe cleaner and bowls of straw beads to share.

Teach Independence:

- Your child should complete the art project as independently as possible. Provide physical assistance when needed, but encourage your child to work independently.
- Place art materials in separate containers.
- Encourage your child to gather their materials prior to the art activity.

Ideas to Encourage Social/Communication Skills

- Throughout the activity, encourage descriptive conversation about each project (the colors and shapes).
- Encourage your child to show others their complete project.

Considerations:

- If completing this activity at home with your child, consider the following:
 - Include siblings, friends, or other family members if you would like.
 - For materials that need to be pre-cut or pre-made, organize them and place them in the area you will be doing art.
 - For other common household art materials, keep them in their usual place and teach your child where those items are located in the home.
 - Complete each step of the art project together as a visual model of the art activity.

Step-by-Step Guide

Take a pipe cleaner and fold one end over so the beads won't fall off. 2 String different colored beads onto the pipe cleaner.



3 When it's almost filled with beads, twist the two ends of the pipe cleaner together to secure the bracelet.
