

Math: Let's Make a Pattern

Action Goal:

Students identify vocabulary pictures and then use the pictures to complete patterns in a group activity.

Materials:

Provided: Needed: Sequence strip or large sequence panels Chart paper (4 sheets) • • Large pattern pictures Permanent marker • • Student pattern pictures Scissors • • Teacher's key Hook and loop fastener • • Plastic bags (8) • Paper clips (4) •

Preparation:

- I. Print, laminate, and cut out:
 - a. Sequence strip or large sequence panels
 - b. Large pattern pictures (I set for each pattern)
 - c. Student pattern pictures (I set per student for each pattern)
- 2. Print the teacher's key.
- 3. If using the large sequence panels, arrange the pictures in order and tape them together.
- 4. Place hook and loop fastener on the back of each large pattern picture.
- 5. Keep the pattern sets separate from one another. Place each complete set of large pattern pictures in its own bag (e.g., one bag for Set I AB, one bag for Set 2 AAB, etc.). Label the bag with the pattern type as identified on the teacher's key.
- 6. Repeat Step 5 for the student pattern pictures.
- 7. Prepare the four pattern charts:
 - a. Turn each sheet of chart paper sideways.
 - b. Place eight pieces of hook and loop fastener spaced evenly across the width of each chart.
 - c. Affix the large pattern pictures to the four charts according to the teacher's key to set up each pattern for students to finish.
 - d. For each of the pattern charts, use a paper clip to attach the bags with the pattern picture sets (i.e., the bag containing the large pattern pictures and the bag of student pattern pictures).





Instructions:


- I. Select the first pattern chart, and use tape as needed to secure it on the wall for the class to see and access.
- 2. Pass out the student pattern pictures for the first pattern. Each student should receive a full set (two or three) of the student pattern pictures that correspond to this pattern. Identify the pictures as a class.
- 3. Review the activity sequence strip.
- 4. Demonstrate the activity:
 - a. Point to the chart paper for the first pattern, which shows only the start of a pattern.
 - b. Model adding the next two or three pictures to complete the pattern.
 - c. Remove the model pictures you used to demonstrate the activity so the chart paper is ready for students to participate.
- 5. Perform the activity:
 - a. Name each large pattern picture as you point to it on the first pattern chart. When you get to the end, ask the students, "What comes next?" Encourage all students to hold up the correct picture.
 - b. After students hold up the correct picture, take the correct large pattern picture and ask for a student volunteer to affix the picture in place on the chart paper.
 - c. Continue until all large pattern pictures have been put in order on the chart paper, and review the completed pattern with the class.
- 6. Repeat the activity with the remaining pattern sets.

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





































Large pattern pictures











Teacher's key

Instructions: Use this key to set up the chart paper for each pattern in preparation for the activity. Attach the amount of large pattern pictures in the order listed onto the chart paper, and draw blank lines where the students will attach the remaining large pattern pictures to complete the pattern during the activity.

Set I – AB pattern:

Cement truck picture, Road worker picture, Cement truck picture, Road worker picture, then 4 blank lines

Set 2 - AAB pattern:

Crane picture, Crane picture, Construction worker picture, Crane picture, Crane picture, then 4 blank lines

Set 3 - ABB pattern:

Construction sign picture, Bulldozer picture, Bulldozer picture, Construction sign picture, then 4 blank lines

Set 4 - ABC pattern:

Pickup truck picture, Ladder picture, Painter picture, Pickup truck picture, Ladder picture, then 4 blank lines
