

Back to School

"Back to School: Vincent's Learning Adventure" Introduction Story

Activity Goal:

Students listen and attend to a story introducing the monthly theme unit and participate by receptively and/or expressively identifying concepts in the book.

Materials:

Provided:

- "Back to School: Vincent's Learning Adventure" story
- "Back to School: Vincent's Learning Adventure" video

Needed:

- Hole punch
- Ring for binding purposes
- Scissors

Preparation:

- I. Assemble the book:
 - a. Print and laminate the book pages.
 - b. Hole-punch the top left corner of the pages.
 - c. To bind the book, place a ring through the hole.

Helpful Learning Tools

- Use the corresponding digital REEL as an alternative or complement to the printable materials.
- Review the Learning Differentiation Guide to individualize this lesson for each student's learning level.

Instructions:

- I. Prior to starting the monthly theme unit, read the story to the class to introduce important theme-related concepts.
- 2. Throughout the story, ask students to identify important theme-related people, places, actions, and/or items in the story:
 - a. Read the story text.
 - b. Ask students a question about the story text and/or pictures (e.g., "Where is the principal?" or "Who is the student waving to?").
 - c. Prompt students to answer the question.
 - **Note:** Students may answer expressively or receptively by pointing to a part of the story illustration.
- 3. Show the complementary video and have students answer questions about the concepts presented.
- 4. Continue reading the book and showing the video throughout the month, increasing the complexity of questions and expected responses as students become more familiar with the unit's theme.



Back to School: Vincent's Learning Adventure




My name is Vincent, and I'm going back to school today! I can't wait to meet my teacher and see my friends!

I also see a crossing guard helping students cross the street.






The bus driver lets us off the bus. I say, "Good morning" to the principal when I see them.





I walk past the office and wave to the secretary.




I continue walking to my classroom. I see my friends and wave hello to them too!
